New talent is the source of future business success. Our Internship Programme helps organisations to fill skills' gaps, fulfil a project that will make a lasting difference and try out possible new staff. We even employ the intern on your behalf during the placement, which can run for up to 12 weeks.

Your intern will be a high-calibre recent graduate or a penultimate-year undergraduate. Our Internship Programme is open to businesses and organisations of all sizes, located in the East of England.

Supporting your business

There are many different ways that our interns help businesses. An internship project could involve:

- setting up IT and e-commerce systems and websites
- writing marketing and business plans
- conducting market research
- analysing and improving production
- assessing the feasibility of a new product or service
- designing company literature
- conducting environmental audits.



HOW INTERNSHIPS WORK

Working closely with you, we will find the candidate with the right skills to meet your specific needs. Although Anglia Ruskin University employs the intern on your behalf, the individual works full-time within your company for the length of the project. We take care of the administration of the entire programme, including advertising the position, setting up interviews and completing all the employment paperwork.





Your project can run between four weeks and a maximum of 12 weeks. The cost to your company is £255 per week, plus VAT. The intern's salary is £230 per week, paid as a training allowance, so it is exempt from Tax and National Insurance payments.

We handle the weekly payments

We simply invoice you for one lump sum to cover the length of the programme approximately half-way through the project. There is no charge if we cannot source a suitable intern. If you subsequently take on an intern as a permanent employee there is no additional fee payable. Shaping product design

Ganchi researched and tested a specific type of touch-screen technology for Visual Planet, manufacturers of the large-format flexible touchfoils that make interactive screens possible.

Within the 12-week placement, Ganchi reviewed the methods available to reduce electromagnetic interference, designed the hardware and software parts required for the approved way forward and tested these parts, making recommendations for further enhancements.
